Program Admission Requirements

1. Applicants who apply for matriculation must hold a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution in the United States or proof of equivalent preparation from a foreign college or university.
2. Applicants must: complete the application form; submit the non-refundable application fee of \$50; forward official transcripts of all course work for each graduate and undergraduate institution attended; and submit Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores or GMAT scores that have been taken within the last five years.
3. Applicants must submit three letters of reference, appraising the candidate's potential and capacity for graduate study. The Reference Letter Forms that are included with the application packet must be used for this purpose.
4. Applicants with a GPA of 3.0 or higher will not be required to take the GMAT Exam.

Admission Categories

Matriculated

Individuals who are matriculated meet all admission requirements per Bachelor's degree or proof of equivalent preparation from a foreign institution, cumulative grade point average, grade point average in the major at the undergraduate level, satisfactory recommendations, satisfactory personal evaluation, and acceptable scores from nationally standardized tests.

Non-Matriculated

1. Students can be accepted in a non-matriculated status and take 2 courses. All necessary paperwork and requirements must be met to move from non-matriculated (temporary acceptance) status to fully matriculated status.

International Students

Students from countries in which English is not the native language must submit the results of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with the matriculation application. Information on TOEFL and other nationally standardized examinations can be obtained from the Office of Career and Life Education, Segal Hall, 215-489-2312.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT DELAWARE VALLEY COLLEGE'S MBA PROGRAMS

1. **Q:** Do I have to take the GMAT Exam for entrance into the MBA Program?
A: It depends. If your undergraduate GPA is over a 3.0, no GMAT is required.
2. **Q:** How many credits can be transferred in from other MBA Programs?
A: A total of six credits can be accepted.
3. **Q:** How fast can I start the program?
A: There are two ways to be accepted in the program. They are Non-Matriculated (Temporary Acceptance) and Full Matriculated (Full Acceptance)
5. **Q:** How much time do I need to complete the program?
A: You are allowed six years to complete the degree.
6. **Q:** Is the program a full time program or only part-time?
A: It is only offered as a part-time program.
7. **Q:** What are the Costs of the program?
A: Tuition cost is \$1,752 per course. There is a \$50 application fee and each semester a technology fee of \$60. (Payable to Delaware Valley College)
